- 1. Align your money management with God's Word so you can have God's blessing on your finances. Deuteronomy 8:18; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Proverbs 3:5-10; Psalm 37:25-26; Proverbs 10:22
- 2. Provide the level of income you really need plus some of your wants. Luke 5:1-7; Proverb 10:4; Proverbs 12:11

- 3. Give faithfully and generously for God's work and other's needs. Leviticus 27:30; Malachi 3:10; Deuteronomy 14:23b; Matthew 23:23

- 5. Spend wisely the money you have and pay off the debt you've acquired. Galatians 5:22-23; Proverbs 21:5; Psalm 37:21; Proverbs 3:27

6. Invest profitably for greater resources for His purposes and your desires. Ecclesiastes 11:2; Proverbs 13:11

7. Free your heart and mind from both anxiety and greed. Ecclesiastes 5:10-12; 1 Timothy 6:6-8; Romans 14:17
