Boldness in the Battle - Week 6

1) God wants to give us the <u>boldness</u> we need to successfully win life's battles and courageously share Christ's love with other.

Definition of Boldness: The willingness to say or do the right thing at the right time regardless of the consequences. Boldness comes from believing God is who He says He is, that He is with us and that He is in ultimate control. *Proverbs 28:1; Acts 4:13; 2 Timothy 1:7; 1 Samuel 17:41-51*

2) One great benefit of gearing up with the armor of God and living prayed up is that your boldness for Christ goes up. You pray for what Paul prayed for and you get it! Ephesians 6:10-20; Philippians 1:12-14; 1 John 5:14; Hebrews 4:16; Ephesians 3:7-8,20; Acts 4:29-31

Law of the Inner Circle: "A leader's potential is determined by those closest to him." **– John Maxwell**

3) Bold believers live <u>looking</u> for divine opportunities to share Christ in word or deed. They believe God wants to use them so they live expectantly and sow faithfully the love of God and the Word of God. *Mark 4:14-20*

Five "C" seeds we can all boldly sow!

- 1. Care and comfort seed- Galatians 5:14; 2 Corinthians 1:4
- 2. Courage seed- Proverbs 12:25
- 3. Confession seed- 1 Peter 2:9
- 4. Counsel seed- James 1:5
- **5. Conversion seed-** Romans 10:9

We are not responsible for the soil just the seed! If we sow abundantly we will reap abundantly. 2 Corinthians 9:6

4) You can also sow by actively <u>supporting</u> NCCTK's bold plan to share Christ in word and deed. Acts 1:8
