Unforgettable - Week 3

The first Christmas was unforgettable because ordinary people experienced the <u>realness</u> of God's greatness and goodness in the gift of Jesus Christ. *Luke 1:30-37; Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 2:6-20* The more <u>real</u> we get with Jesus, the more real Jesus will be to us! We can't fix ourselves, fix others, fix the world or find victory over death apart from faith in Jesus Christ. *Romans 7:21-25; Romans 5:6-9; Psalm 51:17; James 4:8a*

God can still supernaturally <u>conceive</u> in us and do through us what is humanly impossible, if we are willing to work with Him. *John 1:10-13; John 3:3-6; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Ezekiel 36:26; Acts 9:3-15* You can have so much <u>more</u> than an unforgettable Christmas. You can have an eternal friendship with the King of Kings and Lord of Lords now. He'll never, ever forget that you are His! John 1:12; John 10:27-29

Jesus' greatness and goodness are as <u>real</u> today as they were while He was on earth. He is fully alive and ready to freely give real love, real forgiveness, real power and real hope to anyone willing to receive it. *Hebrews 13:8; Revelation 1:17-19; Isaiah 1:18-19*
