Jesus Is... The Healer of my body. I look to Him first for the vitality and healing I need, trusting He has my best interests in mind.

Hebrews 13:8-9a - Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

John 5:1-15, 1 John 4:9-10 - God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

2 Corinthians 12:9-10, 1 John 5:14, John 12:37, Matthew 10:28-31

Jesus Is... The Healer of my soul. He brings healing to my mind, my emotions and my will when I choose to look to Him for my identity and depend on Him to be enough for me.

Matthew 5:4 - Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

James 4:8 - Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

1 Peter 1:8-9, James 1:2-4 - Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.

Jesus Is... The Healer of my Spirit. The greatest healing that

Jesus ever performed is the healing of my spirit. Eternal life is the ultimate healing - I HAVE been healed!

John 5:16-21, Romans 8:15-28 - So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, "Abba, Father." For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children. And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering. Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later.

Life Application Questions:

1. Have you ever experienced supernatural healing in your physical body, or known someone who has experienced a substantiated healing? Share.
2. What has been healed in your mind, your emotions or your will since accepting Christ into your life? Has your faith and trust in Him increased? Share.
3. In what ways are you more dependent on God and less dependent on your own self than before Christ?
4. How does the hope of eternal life and a new body impact how you live and how you think about trials and pain?
