Jesus Is...

Psalm 100:3; Isaiah 53:6

1. Jesus is...The Good Shepherd - He knows my <u>name</u> and I recognize His voice; He leads me and I follow Him. *John**10:1-5; Psalm 42:7*

4. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, <u>knows</u> me completely, understands my every thought and hidden motive and still He welcomes me into the flock. *John 10:14-18; Jeremiah 1:5a; Psalm 139:1-5; 1 Corinthians 13:12*

2. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, wants to give me a good life. The places He leads me are good places - the food He leads me to is good for me. John 10:6-10; Romans 14:17; Psalm 23:1-3

3. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, <u>stays</u> with me 'til the very end- through thick and thin. The troubles and terrors of life don't make Him run - He never abandons me. *John* 10:11-13; Psalm 23:4-6
