Jesus Is...

Serving breaks down barriers of the unknown between people and quickly invites others into the warm relationship of family. Jesus is... The Ultimate Servant. John 13:1-5

1. The Ultimate Servant lays aside their own wants, rights and privileges in order to <u>do</u> for others what only they can do; they take action to make life great for others. *Philippians 2:3-8; John 13:6-11*

4. The Ultimate Servant doesn't limit their serving to just those they like - the Ultimate Servant <u>serves</u> even their enemies and works to win them over.

Romans 12:14-21; John 13:31-35

5. The Ultimate Servant <u>keeps</u> the glory of God the main thing, and keeps in mind that living to serve others out of a love for Christ is the ultimate way to glorify God. *Romans 15:7-8a*

2. The Ultimate Servant <u>recognizes</u> needs, thinks on behalf of others and serves even when others may not realize they need it.

1 John 1:8-9; John 13:12-17

3. The Ultimate Servant <u>invites</u> others to serve alongside them to give others the joy of sharing in the blessing of serving.

Galatians 5:13-14; John 13:18-30
