Worship Unpacked - Give God My Time

God has placed in each of us the potential to long for Him and the desire to be connected with Him-like a mother longs for her baby- all it takes is for us to give Him some time. Eccesiastes 3:11; Psalm 63:1-8; Gen. 1:31a; Exodus 16:29b; Exodus 20:8-10a; Heb. 4:10

Worship is my usual response to an unusual love- a love so beautiful and wonderful that it has changed my life and destiny forever. Psalm 27:4-5; Psalm 39:4-5; Psalm 31:14-15a

- 1. <u>Set</u> aside time with Jesus every morning. Build it into my calendar. When I consecrate my day to Him at the beginning of my day- it will affect my whole day. *Psalm 5:1*
- 2. Give time to love others in Jesus' name. We love Jesus when we love one another and give our time to meet others' needs. Matthew 25:31-40

3. <u>Sanctify</u> time to God by thanking Him for every moment of my every day- this is the "Worshiping Way". Normal, everyday moments become worship-full moments when I acknowledge God as the Giver of them and give Him thanks in return.
