TALENT- Natural aptitude or skill: a special ability that allows someone to do something well.... Webster's Dictionary

TALENT- A way to measure something of great value.... God's Dictionary

TALENT- The essence of who we are, who God created us to be; an avenue of worship...CT Dictionary

1. We worship God with our talent when our heart is set on doing what is <u>right</u>. Matthew 25:21; 2 Chronicles 16:9; Proverbs 4:18

Genesis 6:9 - Noah was a <u>righteous</u> man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time, and he walked in close fellowship with God.

What we all long to hear... Well done my good and faithful servant, you have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your Master's happiness.

- 2. We worship God with our talent when we are <u>available</u> and <u>obedient</u>. *Genesis* 6:9,13,14,22; *Genesis* 7:5,9,16

When God knows we are available, that's when He will use us.

3. We worship God with our talent, despite incredible opposition. *Genesis 6:5,11-12*

"It is easy to be religious when religion is in fashion; but it is an evidence of strong faith and resolution to swim against a stream to heaven, and to appear for God when no one else appears for Him." - Matthew Henry
