

JUMP - Trust God's Best

2 Corinthians 5:17; Joshua 4:16-20

1. Consecrating my life to God's purposes gets me ready to jump into His best. *Joshua 5:1-9; Romans 12:1; Acts 2:38-39; Romans 2:29b; Colossians 2:11-12; Hebrews 4:12; Ephesians 5:15-21*

2. Celebrating God's faithfulness to save me and remembering all He has done for me builds my faith and prepares me for the next battle. *Joshua 5:10-12*

3. As we consecrate, commemorate and celebrate, God is faithful to participate in whatever He wills to advance the Kingdom and accomplish His purposes. *Joshua 5:13-15; Matthew 6:33; Romans 12:1*

4. What do you think about the idea that one definition of holy ground might be where consecration meets participation? Think about other Christophanies: what was going on in those encounters God had with man?
