JUMP - Trust God's Best

1. <u>Together</u> we do battle as the people of God against the enemy, Satan and his world systems. We join with Christ's Church around the world and march together in unity, prayer, worship and support, motivated by love. Christ has already given us the victory; we need to faith-march our way into possessing the land together. *Joshua 6:1; 2 Corinthians 10:3-5; Ephesians 6:10,18*

2. Life's battles are best fought and won by being in <u>fellowship</u> with people who can march through LIFE with us. With God's presence and their help, we can overcome the challenges life throws at us. *Joshua* 6:6-11

3. The big battle for all of us is to march together to win the world- but in the midst of the Battle for Billions, God still remembers the <u>one</u>. Joshua 6:12-17; Psalm 68:6a; Matthew 18:19-20
