

JUMP - Trust God's Best

1. God is a compassionate, encouraging Father to His children who embrace a life of confession and repentance. His desire is to accept me and restore me fully to Himself and His purposes.

Joshua 8:1a; Psalm 103:13; Joel 2:13; Joshua 8:1b-2

2. Our God is the God of second chances. His desire is to bless His children, and His blessing comes through a covenant relationship with Him where I devote my life to Him and His purposes. *Matthew 6:33; Ephesians 2:8-10; Joshua 8:3-8*

3. God has a divine strategy for my life to achieve His purposes. He will give it to me when I take the time to ask Him about it. His strategy results in the enemy being overcome in the lives of people, and their souls being saved. *Jeremiah 29:11-13; Joshua 8:18-19, 26*

2. Why did I receive Christ's forgiveness and salvation?
3. How am I different today, and how is life different today because of Christ?**

4. Kingdom battles are won when I identify the target and persevere in prayer until the purposes of God have been accomplished entirely. *2 Corinthians 10:3-5a; Joshua 8:30*

5. Keeping God and the worship of Him the priority in my life is the key to living out His purposes for me.
