**1.** God provides- we <u>partner</u> with His provision and <u>pick</u> <u>up</u> what He provides for us. *Psalm 103:1-2,5; Matthew 5:5; Exodus 16:11-17* 

## 2. God provides- we <u>partake</u> of His provision and we <u>present</u> from His provision to others. We are blessed to be a blessing. *Exodus* 16:17b-18; Acts 2:42-47

**3.** God provides- we <u>plan</u> and <u>prepare</u> for our future, not only for ourselves and our children, but also for our church family. *Exodus 16:19-22a; Psalm 90:10,14* 

**4.** God provides- we <u>pause</u> to enjoy the peace of God's provision and <u>praise</u> Him for His goodness. *Exodus 16: 22-24*
