Christmas and the Kingdom

1. Christmas is the eternal Kingdom of Heaven reaching us through the baby Jesus Christ- this is the significance of Christmas. *Isaiah 9:6-7; Isaiah 9:1-2; Colossians 3:13-14*

2. Christmas is the eternal Kingdom of Heaven <u>restoring</u> us to peace with God through Christ the King. *Luke 2:14; Romans 5:1*

The Kingdom of God is a Kingdom of peace because through the Kingdom, through Jesus Christ the prince of peace, I have peace with God. God is pleased with me because of Christ in me.

3. Christmas is the eternal Kingdom of Heaven revealing through us, the body of Christ the King, His Kingdom to a world in desperate need of a King. *Romans* 14:17

3 Eternal Attributes that Reveal Christ's Kingdom Through Us:

- Righteousness- made right with God through Christ, I now <u>live</u> in right relationship with others. 2 Peter 1:3
- Peace- at peace with God, I now <u>give</u> my life to help others piece their lives back together in Christ. *Matthew 5:9*
- Joy- fulfilled in Him, I now <u>share</u> the joy of knowing Christ and having my future secure in His Kingdom. *Colossians 1:11b-12; 2 Peter 1:4-8; 2 Peter 1:10-11; Matthew 6:33*
