## In Progress: Spirit, Soul & Body - The True You -

- 1) Anyone, anywhere, at any time can become a new <u>creation</u> through personal faith in Jesus Christ! Believing in Christ makes anyone brand new inside. They are not the same anymore! 2 Corinthians 5:15-17
- 2) Biblically, being a new creation means that you are now a <u>saint</u>, a spiritually born again child of God, a divine masterpiece, a child of light, a citizen of heaven. John 1:11-13; 1 John 3:1-3; 1 Peter 2:9-10; Romans 1:7; Ephesians 5:1-8
- 3) Before we knew Christ we were lied to about everything! Satan is the father of lies and he lied to us about God, about life, about others and even about ourselves. Our self-image, which is our inner self-portrait and how we truly see and feel about ourselves, was infected by Satan's lies and the lies spoken into our lives by our self and others. John 8:44; Prov. 23:7a; Matt. 7:17-18
- 4) When we still believe those lies after our conversion it continues emotional and spiritual bondage in us that often becomes self-destructive behavior or damaging behavior in our relationships. We need the Holy Spirit to renew our minds with the truth about how God our Father really sees us and feels about us so we can live the best life possible for Christ. Romans 12:1-2; 2 Corinthians 5:21
- 5) You can be the <u>true</u> you and live like who you are in Christ by knowing, believing, confessing, standing on and behaving consistently out of your Biblical identity in Christ! John 8:31-32; John 8:36; John 7:38

## The True You in Christ

- I am His adopted child whom He loves unconditionally and He is totally committed to caring for all my needs both on earth and for all eternity. Ephesians 1:5-8; Romans 8:32; Psalm 23:1-6
- I am His new creation free to live the best life possible by surrendering daily to his loving Lordship. 2 Cor. 5:17; Rom. 6:8-12; Psalm 32:8
- I am the living temple of the Holy Spirit who lives in me to transform me and do through me more than I ever dreamed possible. 2 Corinthians 3:17-18; Romans 8:11; Ephesians 3:20-21
- I am His beloved son who is secure under my Father's sovereign control and nothing and no one can snatch me out of His hands. Rom. 8:35; Rom. 8:37-39; Isaiah 43:2-3a; Heb. 13:5-6
- I am a saint being prepared for an eternity with my Father that far exceeds my wildest imagination and is worth giving up anything on earth for! 1 Cor. 2:9; Matt. 19:27-30; Revelation 22:12
