## Stronger Together - The Power to Save -

We are saved by believing in Jesus Christ; it is the Holy Spirit's power that works out the process of salvation in each of us. We become stronger together as we are birthed through His unifying power. John 3:3-6; Acts 4:1-12; John 14:6

1. Even as a mother is intimately connected with her unborn baby in the womb and prepares for it's birth, the Holy Spirit intimately knows us and prepares us to be spiritually born. *Psalm 139:15-17; Ephesians 2:18; John 16:8-9* 

**2. Even as a mother labors and gives birth to her baby, the Holy Spirit labors over us and <u>births</u> us into spiritual <b>life.** *John 3:6b; Romans 8:11; Titus 3:4-5; Romans 8:14* 

**3.** Even as a mother nurtures her child into adulthood, the Holy Spirit nurtures and <u>preserves</u> us until the time comes for us to receive all God has saved us for. *1 Peter 1:3-5; Ephesians 1:13b-14; John 14:16-17a; Romans 8:26-27; 1 Corinthians 6:11b*
