Ephesians: God's Grace for Us We Are Alive

I. We were <u>born</u> into the walking dead. <i>Ephesians 2:1-3;</i> Psalm 51:5; Romans 1:21; Ephesians 2:4-7
2. We are <u>made</u> alive with Christ. Romans 5:8; Romans 10:9; Colossians 3:1-2; Philippians 3:20
 Made us alive: Raised us up: Seated us with Him
3. We are <u>created</u> in Christ to walk in God's purposes for us. Ephesians 2:8-10; Romans 3:22; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; Philippians 1:11

In this series "Ephesians: God's Grace to Us", we are going to SOAP our way through Ephesians. That means for our reading guide, every day there will be just a few verses from Ephesians to meditate on. We will do that by SOAPing. This works best if you have a journal, where each day you:

S- Scripture: Write out each verse

O- Observation: Write out what the verse is saying. You can use a commentary for this.

A- Application: Write out how the verse applies to my life, how does this truth impact me?

P- Prayer: Pray for God to work this truth deep into my mind and heart.
