We belong to one another in Christ, but sometimes we don't feel we belong What can you do to increase the feelings of belonging to the Body of Christ? 2. How important is hope in your life? Share a situation where you are having to hope in Christ, or turn something over to Him for His best. 3. Put into words what it means to you to be at peace with God. Share a situation in life that Christ has helped bring peace to. 4. How do you feel about being "one" with people from every tribe, tongue and nation. How does this reality influence your view of people who are not like you? 5. Given that you are a living stone in God's temple, how well does your life of worship reflect that? Discuss.
