1. God <u>prepares</u> our hearts to receive the Savior. "Let every heart prepare Him room". <i>Micah 5:2-5a; Matthew 5:5</i>
2. God <u>satisfies</u> our hungry hearts every day with the Bread of Life. "I am the bread of life" Jesus John 6:33-35
3. God <u>receives</u> glory when our hearts are being satisfied and restored in Christ. <i>Micah 5:4-5; 1 Corinthians 1:28-29</i>
