Unlikely Heroes Gideon - Unlikely Potential

Judges 6:1-10

- Worshiping idols of the culture leaves me exposed to the cruelty of the culture.
- 1. Unlikely heroes have potential that God sees and calls forth. Judges 6:11-12; Psalm 139:13-16; Judges 6:13-18

 2. Unlikely heroes are not the strongest or the best-

equipped; they are available and willing. Judges 6:19-24

- 3. Unlikely heroes worship God by offering what they have. Judges 6:25-32
 - Potential can only be fully developed when it is fully given.

- 4. Unlikely heroes <u>remove</u> their idols and become fiercely loyal to God and His mission.
- 3 main idols we struggle with:
 - **Control** removed by trusting that God is great and in control

- **Significance** removed by trusting Christ for my significance
- **Comfort -** removed by trusting that God is good and enough for me
