## Unlikely Heroes: Elijah A Man Like Us Depending On God's Grace and Power -

James 5:17-18 - Elijah was as human as we are, and yet when he prayed earnestly that no rain would fall, none fell for three and a half years! Then, when he prayed again, the sky sent down rain and the earth began to yield its crops.

## **ELIJAH: A MAN JUST LIKE US**

In his letter, James reminds us that, "Elijah was a man just like us." Identifying with Elijah is often hard for us to believe when we read the dramatic events of his story. But the mighty acts of God in his life were not due to Elijah's goodness and power but God's greatness and might.

Like us, Elijah suffered with anxiety, despair, unbelief, weakness, loneliness, and want.
