1. We are loved so amazing by God who draws us to Himself with His kindness. “I have drawn you with unfailing kindness.” - Jeremiah 31:3. John 12:32; John 16:7; 2 Corinthians 2:14-15

2. We are loved so amazing by God who seals our salvation with His precious indwelling presence: the Holy Spirit. “The Spirit alone gives eternal life.” - John 6:63. Ephesians. 4:30; Ephesians 1:13b-14

3. True heart change reveals that the Holy Spirit has drawn us and sealed us. “The Spirit makes us more and more like him as we are changed.” - 2 Corinthians 3:18. Matthew 7:20-21; John 15:4-5; Galatians 5:22-23
